

#### AFTERNOON WORKSHOP



Gabi Moisan is a teaching artist with a passion for nurturing creativity, fostering community connections and creating inclusive spaces. She has held space for children, their caregivers & folx of all ages at Smithtown Township Arts Council, Stony Brook University, the Brooklyn Museum of Art, Sachem Library, the Whitney's Learning Through Art program, Film Biz Recycling, & Brooklyn Free Space as Atelierista.

Gabi holds a Master's Degree in Studio Art from Stony Brook University and a B.F.A. in Fine Art from Hunter College. Gabi has focused that enthusiasm in Park Slope & around Brooklyn for the past 16 years including studio classes, exhibits, public and street art, art parties, & pop-ups in public parks.

#### AFTERNOON WORKSHOP



Taryn's aesthetic is heavily influenced by both the Arizona desert landscape of her childhood and natural materials, dyes, and organic processes.

Crochet was first introduced to Taryn at age 7, mentored by a 70 year old crochet and craft artist at the afterschool daycare. First learning granny squares made of scrap yarns, Taryn quickly became interested in different materials, shapes and forms.

Taryn teaches workshops to students of all ages through a visual language. Unlike textbook standards, she simultaneously teaches the form of the craft while guiding the free spirit that is at the tip of your fingers and hook.

In this class, multiple mediums will be used to support each child's creative process.

#### A MONTESSORI APPROACH



Anna Caroline Tehan is a co-founder of Collective Kind and an Early Childhood Special Education + Montessori Certified + Anti-bias Early Education Leader. She brings 14Y experience as a creative arts & early childhood educator internationally and locally in underserved communities, classrooms and foster care settings.

In 2019, Anna Caroline amplified her early childhood education experience in her role as Teacher Trainer with Learning Beautiful, an organization that trains educators in foundational computer science concepts.

With inspiration from tactile approaches, such as the Montessori Method, we will break down the fundamentals of computational thinking into a set of discrete concepts that children as young as 3 can explore with their hands.

#### AFTERNOON WORKSHOP



Seda is founder of Little Hand Brooklyn and Mud On My Hand.

She has been teaching kids and adults in different schools, groups and studios since 2018. In this woekshop we will work on projects with pottery clay. Kids will learn hand building (such as pinch, coil and slab) and glazing techniques.

We use a non-toxic oven bake polymer clay for colorful fun sculptures.

Seda has been teaching at Collective Kind for the past 3 years, and we all love her!
